RCW 28A.150.220 Basic Education-Minimum Instructional Requirements

Requires school district provide minimum instructional offerings for students each school year

- Grades 1-12: 1,027 instructional hours district-wide annual average
- Kindergarten: 1,000 instructional hours
- The school year is accessible to all legally eligible students and consists of at least 180 school days for students

What constitutes Instructional Minutes?

From start bell to stop bell

- Example: 8:30 a.m.-3:00 p.m. = 6.5 hours or 390 minutes/day
- Exclude lunch (20 or 30 minutes depending on grade level)
- Exclude early release days not associated with parent/teacher conferences

Instructional minutes x student days

<u>Total instructional minutes per student</u>

Instructional Minutes are converted to Instructional Hours
