Timeline

- 1. Equity team meeting-Teachers, AD (2017-18)
 - a. Focus primarily on costs
 - b. Looked for other potential barriers
- 2. Changes starting 2018-19
 - a. ALL students get free ASB card (\$35)
 - i. \$28,000 revenue loss (Athletics/ASB)
 - ii. \$14,000 district funded ASB
 - b. Maintain \$60/\$20 participation fee and include2 parent passes (No gift of public Funds)
 - c. No cuts in boys' soccer



Outcomes

- 1. Free ASB
 - a. All students get into games for free and can participate in dances.
 - b. Increase size of student section for Football.
 - c. Reduce cost of athletics from \$95/\$55 to \$60/\$20.
- 2. Parent Passes- All Parents are able to attend games/watch their student athlete play from inside the stadium/gym.
- 3. No cuts in boys soccer-More opportunities to participate. (5 teams)
