

CONTINUITY OF OPERATION PLAN



The priority of the Mount Vernon School District is to maintain the greatest number of staff and students onsite for in-person learning. In some instances, there may be the need to go to remote learning, in a class, school, or the district due to health or safety concerns. If this is the case, MVSD will transition from in-person instruction to remote instruction in order to continue educational services for all students.

This plan was developed by the District Leadership Team, in consultation with stakeholders, using the requirements established by the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI), Washington State Department of Health, Skagit County Public Health, and the Mount Vernon Education Association.

If a class, school, or the district needs to go to remote learning for a quarantined period, students will receive instructional services through both synchronous and asynchronous learning. Class, school, and/or district closures will be communicated using Remind.

Synchronous Learning

- Uses Zoom for instruction
- Requires students and staff to be online at the same
- Will make up the majority of the instructional day
- Instruction is interactive between students and staff
- Attendance is taken during synchronous learning

Technology

- Students will take home their assigned Chromebook from their school to use for instructional purposes during the quarantine period.

Schedules

- Students will receive a daily instructional schedule from their teacher and/or school at the time we move into remote learning.

Special Services

- Staff members will provide the accommodations and/or modifications as indicated by a student's individualized plan.

Food Services

- In the event of an individual building goes to remote learning, meals will be available for curbside pick-up at the closed building. In the event of a full district closure, meals will be available for curbside pick up at the following locations and times:

Maple Lane entrance 11am-12pm

Front doors by the school office. 10am-11:30am

New Main cafeteria entrance on northeast corner entrance by pull through and handicapped parking. 10am-12pm
