
WSU Dual Language Pathway Certificate

Are you working on a Bilingual Education teaching endorsement?

If yes, then check this out:

- ➤ WSU now offers 3 teacher preparation courses in Spanish.
- ➤ The courses are offered via Zoom to all WSU campuses.
- ➤ One course per semester will be offered in Spanish:
 - Fall: TCH LRN 333: Introduction to English as a Second Language
 - **Spring**: **TCH_LRN 330**: *Diversity in Education*
 - Summer: TCH_LRN 411: Bilingual Methods and Materials Across Content Areas

Why take these classes in Spanish?

- Taking courses in Spanish enhances your ability to support multilingual K-12 students and families.
- > Students who complete all 3 courses as part of the Bilingual Education endorsement requirements will be eligible for an official WSU certificate that is indicated on their official transcript the WSU "Dual Language Pathway Certificate."
- ➤ The Dual Language Pathway Certificate indicates that WSU students have taken multiple teacher preparation courses in Spanish and are trained to work in multilingual classrooms.
- ➤ All 3 courses count towards the Washington State Bilingual Education endorsement.

Who should take these classes?

- ➤ All Spanish-speaking education majors earning a Bilingual Education endorsement should take these
- > Students can even take 1 or 2 of the courses to get support in Spanish language development.
- > Students pursuing other endorsements (besides Bilingual Education) can take these courses as a way to develop their professional Spanish language skills.
- > Graduate students can also take these courses but should check with their advisor before enrolling.
- These classes are not necessarily meant for students who want to be a high school Spanish teacher, so please check with your for advisor before enrolling (if you are in a foreign language education program).
